Fel atodiad I'r llythyr a gawsoch ddoe yn eich hysbysu am drefniadau Llywodraeth Cymru i gau ysgolion o ddydd Llun ymlaen mewn ymateb i'r argyfwng COVID-19 hoffwn eich hysbysu o'r canlynol:

1. Bydd yr ysgol ar agor i rai disgyblion blwyddyn 7-9 yn unig, lle na all 'gweithwyr allweddol' drefnu gofal plant. Derbyniom y cyfarwyddyd a ganlyn gan Swyddogion Addysg y Sir:

In the first instance we will have to look at delivering provision and supervision for children whose parents or carers work in Health & Social Care or the Emergency Services (Ambulance, Fire & Rescue, and Police). It's clear we must focus on these groups first to ensure that they can continue to do the essential work required to stop the spread of COVID-19, to care for the sick and to protect the public. The provision will be strictly for children where at least one parent/carer is a key worker and there is no other adult available to look after the children.

CORONA VIRUS / COVID - 19 Update 20.03.20

Dear Parent / Guardian

As an appendix to the letter you received yesterday informing you of the Welsh Government's decision to close all schools from Monday onwards in response to the COVID-19 crisis, I would like to inform you of the following:

1. The school will be open to some year 7-9 pupils only, where 'key workers' are unable to arrange childcare. We have received the following instruction from County Education Officers:

In the first instance we have to look at the provision and supervision of children whose parents or carers work in Health and Social Care or the Emergency Services (Ambulance, Fire & Rescue, and Police). The spread of COVID-19, the care of the sick and the protection of the public, must be maintained. The provision will be strictly for children where there is a key worker and there is no other adult available to look after the children.

- 2. If you are in a position where you have to access the provision mentioned above, then would you please contact us <u>stating your child's name and class</u>, name of the parent who is a key worker, their job title and contact number. The information should be e mailed to Mr Denis Pugh: dpu@glantaf.cardiff.sch.uk
- 3. Free School Meals The Council will contact some families to inform them that lunch packs are being distributed through a local school for your child.
