Start of September Term 2023: It is a pleasure to write to you at the start of a new year at Glantaf as we look forward to welcome pupils back to school. I also hope you have had a restful and enjoyable summer break. Yr7 and 12 will start term on Tuesday 5th of September with all other pupils starting the new term on Wednesday 6th of September.

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A Level, BTEC, AS, GCSE and vocational results: We were delighted to celebrate our students success in their examination results. As regards Year13, the vast majority of students secured places at their first choice Universities or for their placements next year. The overall results were outstanding, with 35% of students gaining at least 3 A*or A at Advanced Level and 91% of all grades awarded being A*- C. These grades are admirable, and speak of the mature dedication and excellent

Year 7 Lunches: In order to register Yr7 pupils on our *ParentPay* system correctly, we kindly ask Yr7 pupils to bring a packed lunch for their first week in school. By Monday 11th September, all accounts should be active. We will then run an induction process for Yr 7 in our canteen on alternate weeks: pupils in 7Dewi and 7Dyfrig access to canteen (week 2, Mon 11th Sept) pupils in 7Illtud and 7Teilo (week 1, Mon 18th Sept). All pupils in Yr7 will have daily access to the canteen from Mon 2nd October.

Road and cycle safety: We welcome the new 20mph legislation and we remind you to not park or pick up / drop off close to the school gates. We encourage pupils to cycle to school using designated cycle lanes and the Taff Trail. All pupils should wear a helmet and bikes need to be locked using our cycle racks and NOT on school railings, where there have been thefts, in the past.

School uniform, mobile phones and punctuality for registration: Many thanks for your support regarding correct school uniform as we welcome pupils back for the new term. We also remind pupils that mobile phones should not be used during the school day, in line with promoting positive messages on wellbeing and reducing screen time. We also ask for your support in not sending texts, messages or making calls to your children during the school day. Pupils who do use their phones will have to hand in their device to reception and collect it at the end of the school day. Finally, a reminder that all pupils need to arrive on campus by 8.30am. Late arrivals, from September will have to register in Reception and hand in their mobile phone for the remainder of the school day. We thank you for your anticipated support in these matters.
