**PC Liaison Officer (PC Mirain Davies):** Thank you to PC Mirain Davies for visiting the school and delivering a presentation on Online Safety to our Year 7 pupils. PC Mirain Davies has also delivered presentations to our Year 8, 9 and 10 pupils during the first half term.

## We would like to remind you of the importance of your child's attendance at school.

Regular attendance is essential to the academic and social development of our learners. We therefore kindly ask you to encourage your child to come to school every day.

- A 95%-100% attendance percentage gives the best chance of success.
- In a school year, 85-90% attendance means your child loses at least 4 weeks of learning which can lead to underachievement and the need for extra support.
- Under 80% means your child loses at least 7 ½ weeks of learning which obviously has a significant impact on learning.

Year 11, 12 and 13 – Mock Examinations: Pupils have received their timetable of examinations this week.

Year 11 – Start on 13/12/23 and Finish on 19/12/23.

Year 12 – Start on 11/12/23 and Finish on 18/12/23.

Year 13 – Start on 8/12/23 and Finish on 19/12/23.
