Welsh-medium education continues to grow in popularity in Wales. The vast majority of pupils in Glantaf (80%+) come from families where Welsh is not the main language of the home. This shows that bilingual and Welsh-medium skills add value to an individual's education and future success while providing a wealth of opportunities.

- Connect directly with Welsh heritage and culture. In Year 7, pupils study 'Coron Gwlad', an innovative course where pupils have the opportunity to explore their school, community and country. The emphasis is on oral work and creativity and during the year, there are various opportunities to learn about our capital city and our country. Pupils will visit their local area; discuss and learn about local, national and global issues, learn the school anthem as well as explore different languages.
- More opportunities in school and within the wider community e.g. Menter Iaith, the Urdd and Welsh organisations.
- Increase job and career prospects.
- Promote thinking skills through bilingual and multilingual learning.
- Develop a wider perspective on Welsh, British, European and Global issues

Ein nod yw i sicrhau bod pob dysgwr yn cael mynediad i gwricwlwm eang, cytbwys a heriol. Rydym yn cydnabod mai egwyddor sylfaenol dysgu ac addysgu yw'r agwedd bwysicaf yn ein hysgol, ac sy'n graidd i ddatblygiad academaidd, emosiynol, ac ysbrydol pob dysgwr.

DARPARIAETH LLES A CHEFNOGAETH FUGEILIO

Mae ein **tiwtoriaid personol** yn chwarae rhan hanfodol i ddarparu cefnogaeth ac arweiniad i'w disgylion. Mae eu cyfrifoldebau yn cynnwys cadw cofnod o les, gwisg, presenoldeb disgylion a chydweithio clos gyda'r Arweinwyr Cynnydd a Lles.

Bydd disgylion yn aros yn yr un dosbarthiadau cofrestru drwy flynyddoedd 7 - 11. Bydd tiwtor personol yn dod i adnabod pob unigolyn yn ei ddosbarth yn dda. Bydd bob amser yn barod i wrando a chynnig cyngor ynglŷn â gwaith ysgol neu broblemau personol.

Atgyfnerthir gwaith a gofal y Tiwtor Personol gan yr **Arweinwyr Cynnydd a Lles**. Mae gan bob blwyddyn ei Arweinydd Cynnydd a Lles sy'n gweithio ar y cyd gyda'r Arweinwyr Cwricwlwm. Maen nhw'n monitro a chefnogi disgylion i'w galluogi i gyrraedd eu potensial. Nhw yw'r pwynt cyswllt cyntaf i ddisgylion a rhieni sy'n wynebu anawsterau neu sydd angen cymorth yn yr ysgol.

Gwnawn ein gorau i greu hinsawdd lle mae disgylion yn barod i drafod eu teimladau. Rydym felly yn cynnig **ymyraethau lles a iechyd meddwl** penodol, rhai ar sail cefnogaeth un-i-un, eraill mewn grwpiau.

Darperir rhain yn fewnol gan staff a hefyd gan gyfoedion a thrwy bartneriaeth gydag asiantaethau allanol:

WELFARE PROVISION AND PASTORAL SUPPORT

Our **personal tutors** play a vital role in providing support and guidance to their pupils. Their responsibilities include keeping a record of pupils' welfare, uniform, attendance and working closely with their Progress and Wellbeing Leaders.

Pupils will remain in the same registration classes through years 7 - 11. A personal tutor will get to know each individual in their class well. They will always be willing to listen and offer advice about school work or personal problems.

The work and support of the Personal Tutor is reinforced by the **Progress and Wellbeing Leaders**. Each year group has their Progress and Wellbeing Leader who work collaboratively with the Curriculum Leaders. They monitor and support pupils to enable them to reach their potential. They are the first point of contact for pupils and parents who are experiencing difficulties or need support in school.

We aim to create a climate where children are willing to discuss their feelings safely and confidently. We therefore offer specific **wellbeing and mental health interventions**, some on the basis of one-to-one support, others in group work.

These are provided by staff and also by peers and through partnership with external support:

- Talkabout (social skills)
- Key Worker (Additional support)
- ELSA (Emotional Literacy)
- 'Buddy' provision (Peer Mentors)
- Seren scheme with Peer Mentor scheme, focus on anti-bullying
- Anger management workshops
- County Counselling Service
- School nurse service
- Mental Health Service (CAHMS)
- Access to our **Wellbeing Hub** during break and lunch.



GWEITHGAREDDAU ALLGYRSIOL

Mae cymryd rhan mewn gweithgareddau allgyrsiol o fudd i ddatblygiad cymdeithasol myfyrwyr. Mae'n gyfle i adeiladu sgiliau gwaith tîm a gwella cyfathrebu. Mae'r gweithgareddau yn hybu perfformiad academaidd; rhoi cyfle i ddisgyblion archwilio dioddordebau newydd; a datblygu sgiliau estynedig sy'n gallu arwain at wella hyder a hunan werth yr unigolyn.

Ein nod yng Nglantaf yw rhoi addysg gyflawn i bob disgybl a chânt y cyfle i ddatblygu eu dawn a'u hyder mewn nifer helaeth o feisydd y tu allan i'r ystafell ddosbarth.

- Ceir gweithgareddau llys e.e. Traws Gwlad, Eisteddfod, Athletau.
- Mae amserlen allgyrsiol yr Adran Addysg Gorfforol yn rhoi cyfle i bawb gymryd rhan mewn amrywiol gampau a cheir gemau/cystadlaethau cyson rhwng gwahanol ysgolion.
- Cynhelir gweithgareddau Celfyddydau Mynegiannol yn gyson gan roi cyfleoedd i ddisgyblion fod yn aelodau o bartion canu a chorau, grwpiau drama, celf neu gerddorfa.
- Cefnogir amrywiol weithgareddau'r Urdd
- Ceir llawer o weithgareddau gyrfaoedd e.e. ffeiriau gyrfaoedd, gweithgareddau STEM a gweithdai ymarferol.
- Mae pwylgorau gwahanol i'r disgyblion fod yn aelodau ohonynt e.e. Fforymau Blwyddyn, Senedd Ysgol, Senedd Gwrth-Hiliaeth a Chynhwysiant ac amrywiol grwpiau.
- Mae ymweliadau (lleol / yng Nghymru/ tramor) yn rhoi cyfleoedd i ddisgyblion ehangu eu gorwelion e.e. canolfannau awyr agored, cysiau maes, sefydliadau gwahanol, gwobr Dug Caeredin.

Edrychwn ymlaen at eich gweld yn ein perfformiadau cyhoeddus sy'n adlewyrchu doniau'r disgyblion ar draws y cwricwlwm ac yn amlygu cyfraniad ac ymroddiad llawer o adrannau.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Participating in extracurricular activities is beneficial to students' social development. Group activities build team-work and communication skills, which are necessary for success in the workplace and future careers. The activities boost academic performance; give pupils a chance to explore new interests; and create broader perspectives that can lead to higher levels of confidence and self esteem.

Our aim at Glantaf is to provide a well-rounded education for all pupils where they have the opportunity to develop their skills and confidence in a broad range of contexts outside the classroom.

- There are house activities in the school e.g. Cross Country, Eisteddfod, Athletics.
- The PE Department's extracurricular timetable gives everyone the opportunity to participate in various sports and numerous games/ competitions between different schools.
- Expressive Arts activities are held providing opportunities for pupils to be a member of drama or art groups, choirs, bands and orchestral groups.
- We support the Urdd's various activities
- There are many careers activities e.g. careers fairs, STEM activities and practical workshops.
- Different student forums to foster pupil voice e.g. Year Forums, School Senedd; Anti-Racism and Inclusion Senedd and various sub-committees
- Local and foreign school visits give pupils opportunities to extend their horizons in e.g. outdoor pursuit centres, field trips, Duke of Edinburgh Award and numerous others.

CANOLFAN GLANTAF

Canolfan Glantaf offers specialist provision for pupils with ALN aged between 11 and 19 years, within a vibrant and successful Welsh Medium setting at Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Glantaf.

We are privileged to have a Specialist Resource Base (SRB) for learners with severe and complex needs and for learners with Autism within the school community. This is funded by Cardiff County Council and is the only Welsh-medium SRB in South East Wales. Learners who benefit from access to the SRB also have full access to our wider school facilities and are fully included in our school's activities.

Canolfan Glantaf is highly regarded within the sector for its provision, support and care and has several strengths not least its experienced and specialist staff who care for, challenge and nurture our learners.

We offer a broad, balanced and relevant curriculum throughout the school.

YEARS 7,8 AND 9

Subjects: Welsh, English, Mathematics, Science, French or German, History, Religious Education, Geography, Art, Music, Drama, Design and Technology, Information Technology, Physical Education, Well-being, Coron Gwlad (Yr 7).

Years 7, 8 and 9 are organised into three teaching bands of equal ability range. Teaching classes are mainly based on registration classes in Yrs 7 + 8 which are mixed ability. Mathematics has ability sets from Yr 7 and Welsh from Yr 8.

At the end of Yr 8, learners are able to choose 4 non-core subjects to continue in Yr 9.

YEARS 10 AND 11

Core subjects : Welsh, English, Mathematics, Science, Religious Education, Welsh Baccalaureate Skills Challenge Certificate, Well-being.

YEARS 12 AND 13

Learners are able to choose 3-4 subjects.
